The Department of Insurance (LDI) hereby exercises the emergency provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, [R.S. 49:962](#), as further specified by [R.S. 22:11](#), and pursuant to the authority granted by [R.S. 22:1 et seq.](#), repromulgates to adopt Emergency Rule 49. **Emergency Rule 49 is being repromulgated to adopt a termination date of September 18, 2024, which coincides with the termination date of Executive Order Number JML 24-142.** Emergency Rule 49 is issued to address the statewide public health emergency declared in the state of Louisiana due to the significant rainfall and devastation caused by Hurricane Francine and its aftermath. Emergency Rule 49 applies to insureds who reside in or have insured property located in one of the following twenty-five (25) parishes: Ascension, Assumption, Cameron, East Baton Rouge, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lafourche, Livingston, Orleans, Plaquemines, Pointe Coupee, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. James, St. John the Baptist, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Terrebonne, Vermilion, Washington, and West Baton Rouge. Additionally, Emergency Rule 49 is issued pursuant to Executive Order Number JML 24-142, declared on September 9, 2024, by Governor Jeff Landry.
