Tropical Storm Henri

Tropical Storm Henri was declared a catastrophic event for purposes of <u>R.I. Gen. Laws</u> § 27-10-8 and 27-10.1-1. However, the storm was a Tropical Storm and not a Hurricane at the time it reached landfall in Rhode Island. Therefore, pursuant to <u>R.I. Gen. Laws</u> § 27-76-2 and 230 RICR-20-05-13.4F, hurricane deductibles are not applicable to any losses as a result of the storm.

Insurers are also reminded to make themselves aware of the provisions of <u>R.I. Gen.</u>
<u>Laws § 27-76</u> and <u>230-RICR-20-05-13 Weather Related Claims</u> when adjusting losses.
