

EXTENSION OF AMENDED PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE ORDER

The director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon, acting under the authority in ORS 731.870, issued an Amended Property and Casualty Insurance Order effective Aug. 1, 2020 through Aug. 30, 2020, directing all insurers transacting property and casualty insurance in Oregon to extend deadlines for reporting claims, provide grace periods for premium payment, suspend cancellations and non-renewals, and provide other specified relief to Oregon insureds.

The director has determined that the COVID-19 outbreak in Oregon, which resulted in a state of emergency,¹ continues to substantially interfere with the public's ability to carry on its normal course of business. The director, therefore, extends the duration of the Amended Property and Casualty Insurance Order to be in effect through Sept. 29, 2020.
